

Who can be nominated?

"Excellence in Education" Award Recipients must be teachers who have been in any of the Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Sioux City for five consecutive years or more.

"Good Shepherd" Award Recipients can be any school employee who has been employed in any of the Catholic Schools for five consecutive years or more. Previous years' award winners have included school administrators, principals, administrative assistants, custodians, etc.

WHO CAN SUBMIT NOMINATIONS?

Anyone can nominate another person for either of the two awards. Examples include teachers nominating fellow teachers, PTO Organizations nominating school employees, parishioners nominating teachers and/or employees, etc.

Parents are also encouraged to submit nominations!

WHAT DOCUMENTATION IS REQUIRED?

"Excellence in Education" Nominations must include:

- Nomination Form
- A letter from the nominator(s) detailing why the nominee should be chosen for the award.
- A letter of support from school principal and/or president
- A letter from additional supporter (pastor, fellow teacher, parent, etc.) "Good Shepherd" Nominations must include:
 - Nomination Form
 - A letter from the nominator(s) detailing why the nominee should be chosen for the award.
 - A letter of support from school principal and/or president
 - A letter from additional supporter (pastor, fellow employee, parent, etc.)
